This module will cover the relevance of ergonomics to musculoskeletal medicine with particular reference to the neck, shoulder and upper limb. Recognition of WRLD/ RSI syndrome and differentiation from discrete conditions will enable the student to make confident diagnoses. Detailed examination, differential diagnosis and treatment techniques (including indications for surgery) of shoulder, elbow, wrist and hand will be covered. This is an important module to gain confidence in injection techniques in the clinic sessions.
